# Saboteurs strike at Pretoria's oil installations

In a major strike against South Africa's vital oil plants, African National Congress saboteurs yesterday left firemen to battle against giant fires at Sasolburg in the Free State and smaller fires at Secunda in the Transvaal.

The pillar of smoke and flame which hung over the Sasol plant and the Nafref refinery at Sasolburg bore visible evidence to what specialists in strategic studies yesterday described as a new phase in the guerrilla war against the South African Government.

The Minister of Energy Affairs, Mr F. W. de Klerk, implicitly acknowledged the skill of the saboteurs when he said: "It is clear that we are faced with a sophisticated attack." He referred to the simultaneous and coordinated attacks on the Sasol I and Natref plants at Sasolburg and the

The attacks were launched late on Sunday night. In both cases the saboteurs appear to have cut holes in the security fences before successfully placing and igniting their explosives. No arrests were reported by police yesterday.

The ANC yesterday claimed responsibility for the attacks. The last major ANC attack was made in April. It, too, represented an escalation in the guerrilla war. In that it was the first attack on a police station in a white residential area. No arrests have been announced since the attack.

The attacks on the Sasol plants occurred only a few hours before the appearance in court yesterday of nine alleged

members of the ANC on charges under the Terrorism Act for alleged involvement in the taking of hostages at a bank near Pretoria in January and an attack on a rural police station late last year.

The deputy Minister of Defence and National Security, Mr Kobie Coetsee, said yesterday of the Sasol attacks: "All steps will be taken to see that there is no recurrence." Mr Coetsee declined to elaborate, but his statement was interpreted to mean that the defence force would take over protection of key industrial plants such as those of Sasol.

The managing director of Sasol, Mr J. A. Stegmann, said in a statement yesterday: "The Sasol plants and Natref are continuously patrolled by security personnel." Given their strategic importance, however, observers yesterday expressed surprise that they were not guarded by the police and military.

The explosions set fire to four tanks at Sasol I, where they ignited a "tank farm," and three more tanks at the nearby Natref refinery, Mr Stiegmann said. At the Sasol II plant the fire was less serious as it did not take place in a tank farm, he added.

The Sasol I and II represent what Professor Arnt Spandau, former professor of business economics at the University of the Witwatersrand, in Johannesburg, has described as South Africa's "major defence" against the threat of an oil boycott. Sasol I and II process oil from coal.

We don't know if you keep files going back as far as 1979, but we hope you will be able to give us the answers to the following questions:


1. Has the above vessel indeed called at Westernport on or around the dates indicated?

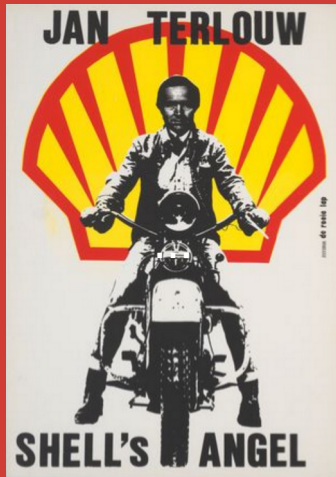
