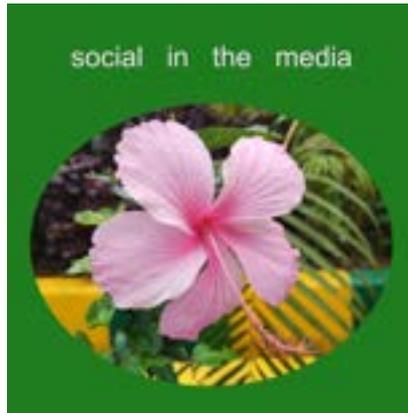


# WELCOME TO THE FEDIVERSE

Have you looked into them but still don't understand what the heck is the fediverse no matter how many times someone explains it to you?

## GLOSSARY

### Fediverse

The fediverse is a distributed ensemble of social networks and online communities that can all communicate with each other. Together, they form this “federated universe”. It includes social media projects such as Mastodon or Akkoma, media sharing platforms such as Pixelfed or PeerTube, certain WordPress blogs, and many others. If you’re a member of one of those, you can follow and interact with anyone on any other. (from <https://symbol.fediverse.info/en>)

### Server

A computer that makes information available to other computers

### Instance

While a traditional social networking service will host all its content on servers managed by the owner of the website, the decentralized structure of the Fediverse allows any individual or organization to host a social platform using their own servers (referred to as an “instance”). (from wikipedia)

### Protocol

The underlying language that allows for users and instances to interact with one another.

### Handle

A handle is a chosen name that is used to identify and represent your profile. On the fediverse, a handle combines your username with your server name, for example like this: username@servername.org.

### Mastodon

Mastodon is a decentralized microblogging social network run on independent servers. This means that

Mastodon is a piece of software that people install on their servers that allows users on different servers to connect to one another.

## CHOOSING A FEDIVERSE SERVER

One of the first steps to take is finding a suitable server for yourself. Your server choice influences the local timeline view (a timeline of the posts of the users on a particular instance), the federated view, which servers you see (some servers choose to block other servers), the moderation frameworks that are used
